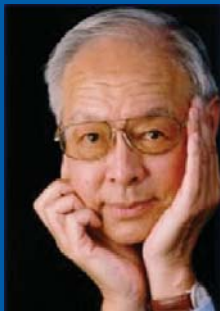
Innovative ways to meet the challenges of the future.

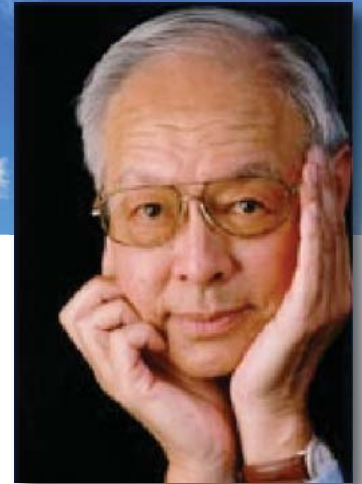
